red/pink eyes

swollen eyelids

crusty eyelashes

light sensitivity

Conjunctivitis occurs when the white part of the eye becomes red and swollen. Infectious forms of conjunctivitis can be spread easily from person to person.

HOW CAN I GET CONJUNCTIVITIS?

Coming into direct contact with the discharge from an infected eye

Coming into direct contact with an item that has discharge from an infected eye on it

HOW CAN I PREVENT GETTING CONJUNCTIVITIS?



Wash hands properly with soap and water after coming in contact with another person's eye

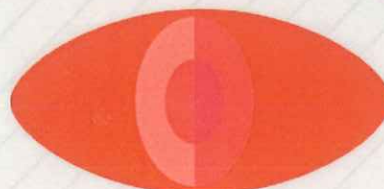
Avoid touching or rubbing the eye
